

PROFESSIONAL ATTIRE FOR THE CLINICAL SETTING

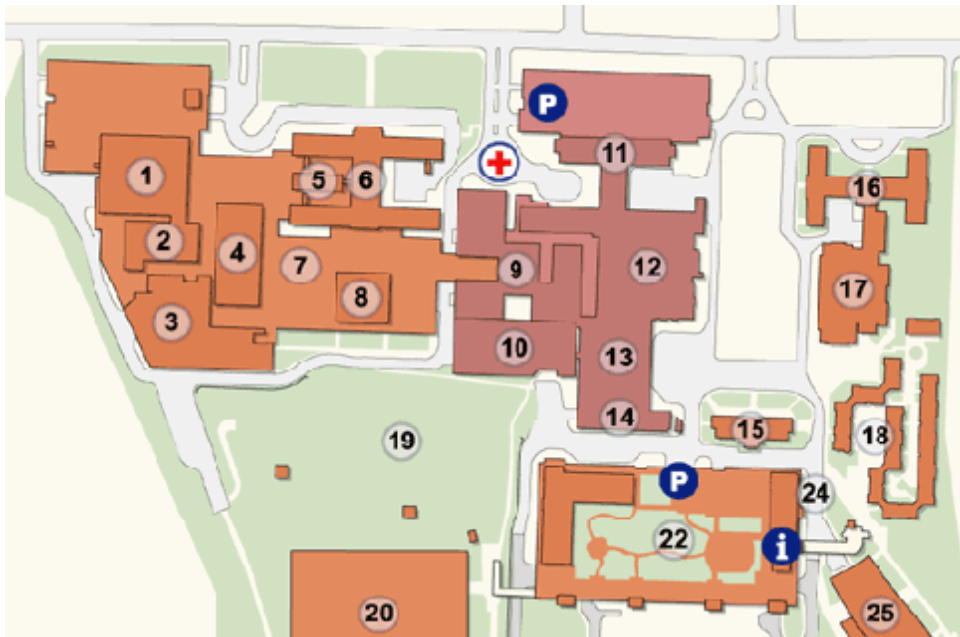
UNIFORM ACQUISITION:

Uniforms and nametags can be picked up and purchased at the Georgetown University Medical Center Bookstore. The bookstore is located in the Preclinical Science Building on the Ground Floor (see map below). You will be able to try on the uniforms prior to purchasing them. Shoes will not be available for purchase at the Medical Center Bookstore and must be bought separately.

All nursing students must be in full uniform on the first day of their clinical agency assignments.

The **School of Nursing and Health Studies** is located in **St. Mary's Hall**, which is marked **number 16** on the map below.

The **Medical Center Bookstore** is located in **room GM-8** within the **Pre-Clinical Science Building**, which is marked **number 7** on the map below.

1. White NHS Cardigan Jacket with Emblem



Sturdy construction nurse's jacket with 2 piece back and sleeves. Button-up front with two front pockets and elastic cuffs. Embroidered patch on left chest.

4. Nametag

- First and Last Name (LINE ONE)
- “Georgetown University” (LINE TWO)

5. All-white or all-black closed-toe and closed-back leather shoes with socks or skin tone hose (athletic shoes are acceptable if all white or all black).

ADDITIONAL CLINICAL SUPPLY REQUIREMENTS:

- Stethoscope
- Watch with second hand
- Pen and notebook (pocket-size is preferable)
- Bandage scissors
- Other equipment as required by specific clinical rotation site

DRESS CODE FOR COMMUNITY SETTING:

In clinicals where the standard NHS uniform is not required, the professional dress code will be consistent with the requirements of the clinical course.

DRESS CODE FOR CLINICAL SETTING:

When in the clinical agency with uniform requirements, the uniform is to be worn for all aspects of the clinical day, inclusive of pre- and post-conference. When going to the clinical site after clinical hours, an ID and nametag along with a lab coat or jacket and dress slacks/skirt should be worn - no jeans.

A student who is not dressed professionally may be asked to leave the clinical site by the faculty or the agency staff. A make-up clinical day will be required. Repeated dress code violations may result in a clinical failure.

PROFESSIONAL ATTIRE, APPEARANCE AND BEHAVIOR:

As a Nursing Major, you are beginning a professional career. With this commitment comes the responsibility to project an image which generates trust and confidence in the people you serve. It is also important to remember that you are representing the profession of nursing and Georgetown University at all times.
